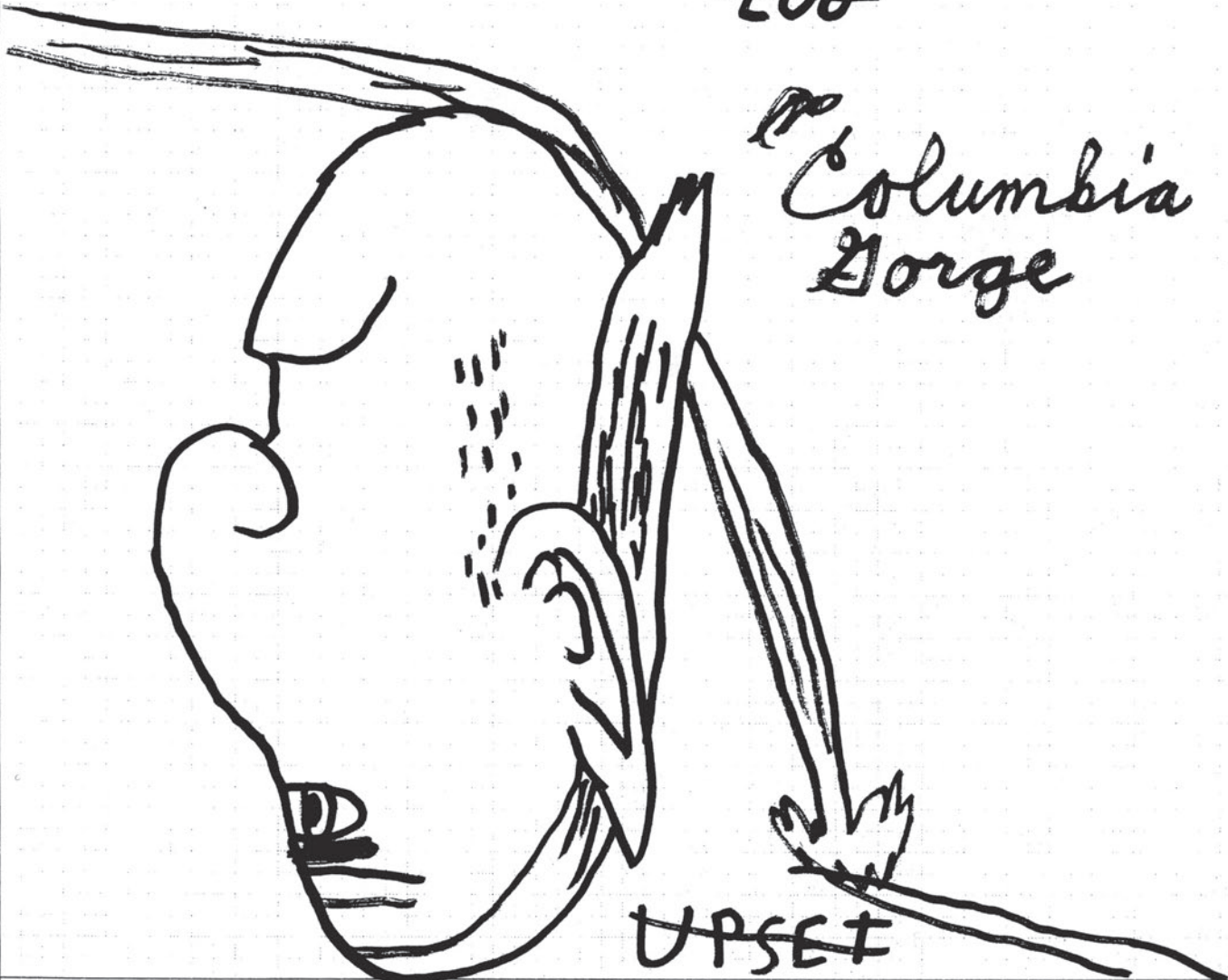

of longing."



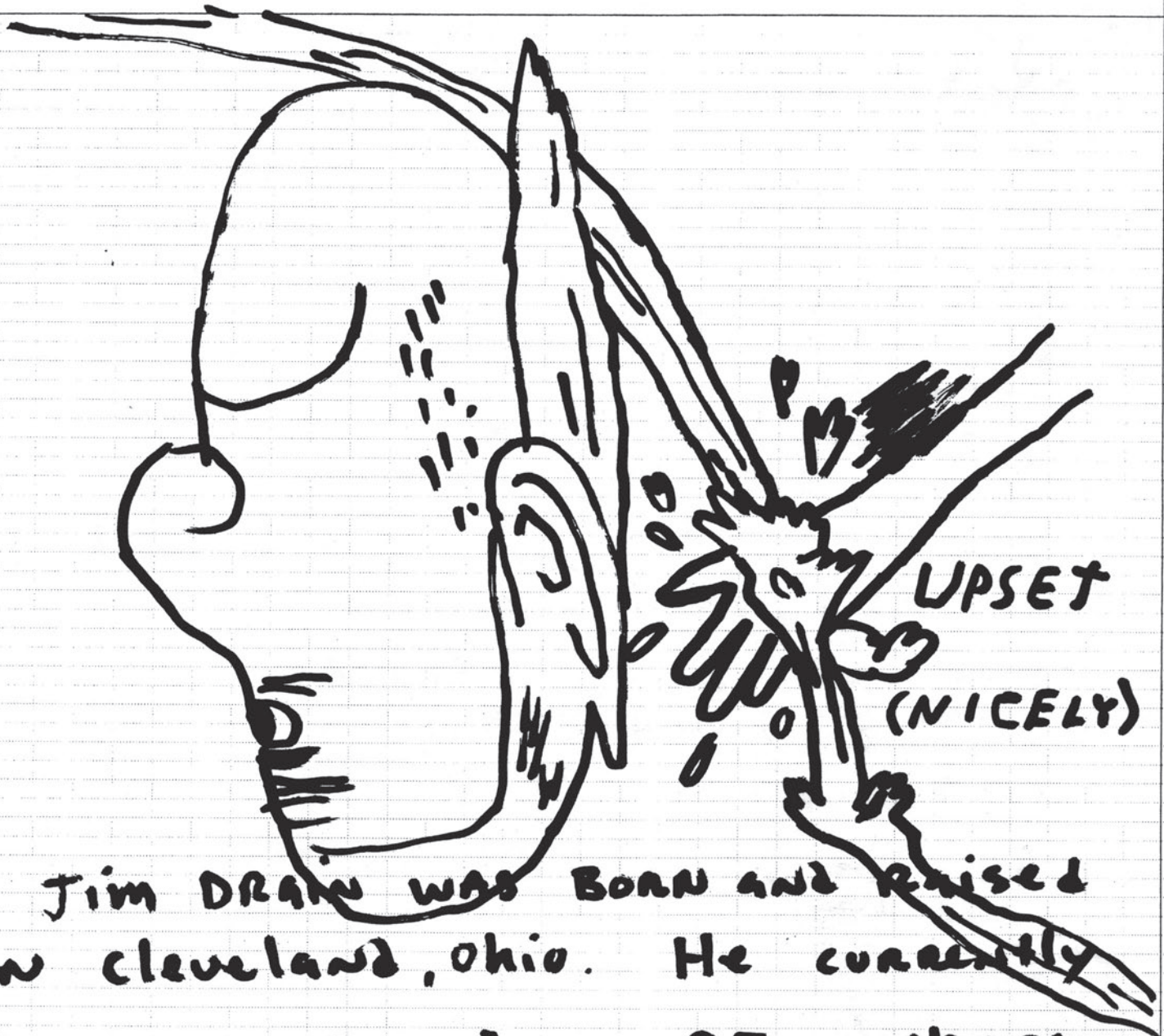
HARRELL AND I
